Please consider this letter your special invitation to participate in our 47th Annual Summer Tractor and Engine show, August 15-18, 2024 sponsored by the Maumee Valley Antique Steam and Gas Association. We be featuring John Deere, J.I. Case Ford and Ferguson, and garden tractors and gas engines. All other exhibitors are also welcome.

The show includes exhibits of antique cars, trucks, steam engines, gas engines, tractors, garden tractors, a trading post, flea market and quilt display. Activities conducted during the show include sawmill operation, shingle mill operation, threshing, plowing, tractor pull Friday and Saturday and blacksmith demonstrations. The Dekalb County Horseman will be providing hay rides Friday and Saturday and the Flying Circuits will be conducting model airplane flying demonstrations.
